
Having trouble collecting parking fines from habitual offenders? There is a way to get these offenders' attention.



DETER – Drivers with Excessive Tickets Excluded from Registration.

The Ohio BMV created the DETER program in 2005. This system is designed to block renewals of, applications for, or transfers of, vehicle registrations for persons with either 3 or more unpaid parking tickets or just one single violation for parking in a handicapped space. To participate in the DETER program the information must be transmitted electronically to the BMV. The PTTS software has a built-in function which can electronically send information about these tickets to the BMV's DETER system. This block can only be removed when the offender's tickets are ALL paid or dismissed. A release is then sent to the BMV so that the offender can renew their plates.


PARKING TICKET TRACKING SYSTEM[™] (PTTS) FEATURES

Ticket Management

Information is entered and tracked for vehicle. violation, issuing officer, vehicle owner (including rental agency), assessed monies (including late fees), billing, payments, and disposition.

- Tickets –
- Record individual or rental agency as vehicle owner
- Enter violation information—including number and description
- Assess late fees either manually or set up control files to automatically add up to 3 late fees
- Assess other fees as necessary (ie-towing)
- Enter payments and print receipts
- Print lists of tickets by owner or plate number
- Print bills individually for selected tickets (see Billing for batch processing of bills)
- Issue a DETER registration block for unpaid tickets.
- Dismiss and/or close tickets
- Searches Ability to look up ticket information using the following criteria - ticket number, plate number, owner name, SSN/tax ID, ordinance, date issued, ticket paid by, check number
- Notes Add free form notes to tickets in the system to track phone calls and other important information.
- Court Date Schedule violator for a court date and print a Notice to Appear letter and envelope.

- Post billing and track how many times owner has been billed to comply with DETER processing

BMV Functions

- Electronically send list of plate numbers to the BMV to request owner registration information (BMV fees apply)
- Electronically update tickets missing owner in-formation with data received from BMV
- Send DETER blocks to the BMV electronically and automatically add the DETER fees onto the ticket
- Retrieve DETER block responses from the BMV - including valid additions and/or rejections
- Clear DETER blocks electronically with the BMV
